EPA's Brownfields Program is designed to empower states, communities and other stakeholders to work together to prevent, assess, safely cleanup and sustainably reuse brownfields. Brownfields grants - assessment grants, cleanup grants, revolving loan grants, and job training grants- serve as the foundation of the Brownfields Program. The Small Business Liability Relief and Brownfields Revitalization Act ("Brownfields Law") specifically identifies sites contaminated by petroleum or a petroleum product as eligible for grant funding. This presentation will introduce the audience to the Brownfields petroleum grant program, as well as provide information and guidance on site eligibility and the grant application process.
