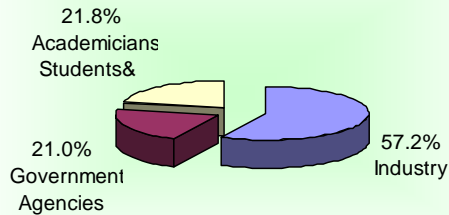
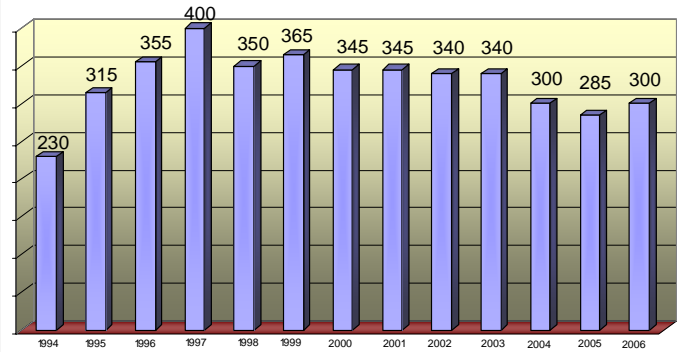


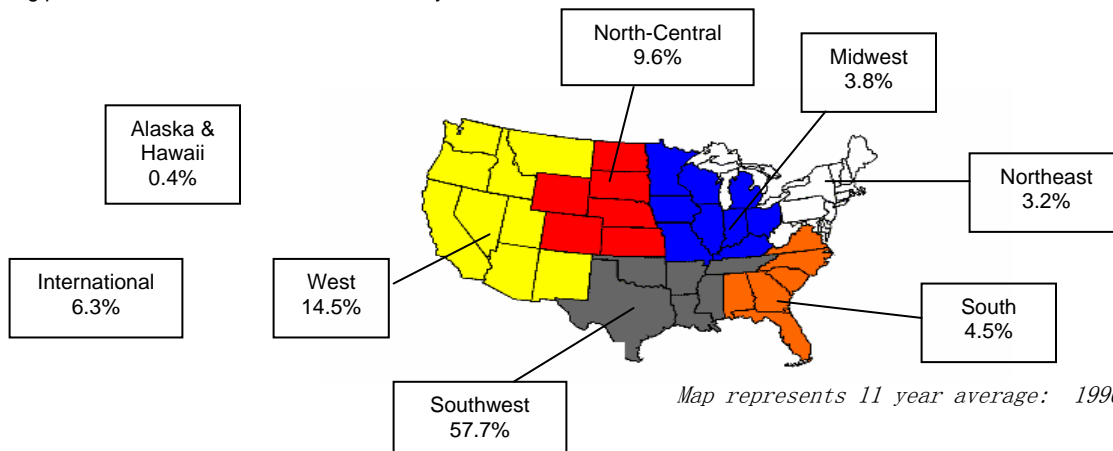
Chart represents 11 year average: 1996 through 2006
