

**Oil and Gas Construction and the Changing Environmental Landscape: Working
with the New/Revised Regulations**

This workshop will discuss a variety of recent changes to environmental regulations associated with construction activities in the oil and gas industry. Congress, the Executive Branch and the Supreme Court have all changed the environmental regulatory landscape – sometimes for the benefit of the industry. Changes to the stormwater rules will be discussed as well as the recent Supreme Court ruling on the wetlands permitting. The nationwide permits (Section 404 of the Clean Water Act) are up for renewal and proposed changes will be discussed. In addition, rule changes associated with Phase 1 environmental site assessments, under the all appropriate inquiry, will be discussed. This workshop will also discuss archeology, environmental management systems, water rights issues, and threatened and endangered species.
