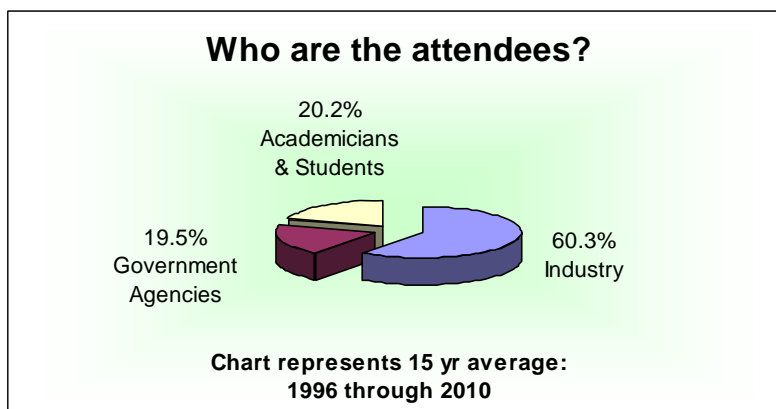
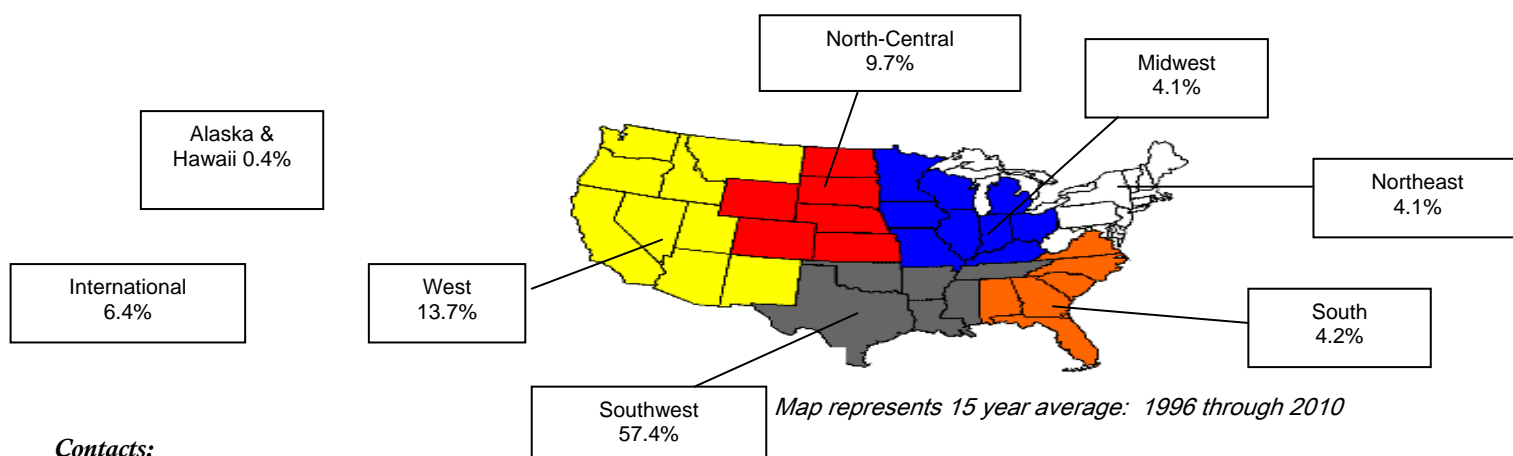


INTERNATIONAL PETROLEUM ENVIRONMENTAL CONFERENCE
